New album out soon

The fourth Bacon Fat album 'Band of Brothers' will be released at the end of February 2016. Recordings took place in August and September, while the mixing and mastering was finished in October. All of this was engineered by **Gérald Jans** at Noise factory Studio in Namur. Interesting fact: This is the first ever digital recording by Bacon Fat and at the same time it's the first recording to be released on vinyl as well.

So let's have a look at what to expect from the new album. There's eleven songs, good for 50 minutes of music. A few of those songs have been performed frequently over the last few years so if you did catch the band you probably heard some tracks already.

The opening song is the oldest original. 'You Better Get Running' was the first song written right after the release of 'The Art of Freedom' in 2011. It debuted live on air at a Dutch radio show in that same year (there is a recording somewhere). It has been in the set ever since with a few exceptions maybe. This is the only track on the new album written by the previous line-up. Which means all the other tracks are more or less brand new.

'Rock & Roll Lover' is the first track composed with Neelzz in the band and has been on and off in the set since October 2013.

In Januari 2014 'Heartbreaker' debuted live on air at the Durango Sessions radio show. This song just had the vibes and it will eventually become the promo single accompanied by a notorious video clip. More about that further down the newsletter.

The fourth song you will most likely know is a reprise of **The Doors'** 'L.A. Woman'. This track has been added to the set since Neelzz joined the band, though it was brought in by W.'s very first bass-player from the high-school days in the early nineties **Wil Mathijs** (now film producer at Elementrik Films and bassist for **The Mary Heart Attack**) who attended a jamsession with the band once.

So there's seven tunes left and the least we can say is they're not boring at all. Where the band experimented a lot with psychedelic stuff, free jazz and stoner on the previous album, they now seem to have managed to integrate all those influences much better into their blues-rock based sound.

Let's see what we got here: Needless to say the guitar-sound is 85% ZZ Top, especially when you know the only axes used here are a Les Paul Billy Gibbons Goldtop and a Chiquita (designed by Erlewine guitars AND Billy Gibbons back in 1979).

So the sound IS there. What about the blending of other musical styles? Well, most remarkable at first sight/listening is the return of reggae in a few tracks. Further listening will unveil some gypsy and African influences while the stoner and psychedelic stuff remain in support of the blues and rock throughout the album.

The biggest surprise here will probably be the mix of blues-rock with that other foundation of black music. Yes we're talking about hip-hop and that's where Neelzz comes in. With his background in hip-hop music the band was destined to at least try to include that in a song. And so Bacon Fat did. It took more than 2 years to refine the song but now it's there. Even the lyrics get real gangsta-style.

With all this in mind you know what to do: the release-party will be held somewhere at the end of February, probably somewhere in Hasselt. We will keep you posted through Facebook and our website.

Digging For Root Tour 2014-2015

Well, to be honest this tour was a big success. The band played 37 shows and is ready for more. In the previous newsletters we already covered the first 16 gigs so now we will give you a short overview of the other shows.

First there was the gig at the <u>Blauwe Kater</u> in Leuven on March 23rd. First show in 13 (!) years in Leuven, packed house, super vibes. Then there was the boat-show in Liège at <u>Péniche Legia</u> (April 3rd).

On April 30th the band started a series of 10 gigs in 6 weeks. It started in Brussels (<u>Archipel</u>) and then passed in Hasselt (<u>In de Kleine Hal</u>, May 8th) where the band actually did it's only acoustic full show to date (with **W.** actually playing an acoustic guitar and Rico playing the cajon). Next up was the <u>Rock Village</u> in Horion-Hozémont (May 15th) where 2 French bands (**Toys in the Forest** and **Oil City Band**) opened for Bacon Fat.

The day after the boys played the <u>Whisky for Charity</u> festival in Heers (May 16th) and got back to Brussels again (<u>café Bizon</u>, May 20th) to play their first 'semi'-acoustic show (with **W**. now replacing the acoustic axe with an electric, but still no Marshall amp). Two days later Bacon Fat was on stage at <u>Paddock's Place</u> in Tessenderlo for a standard double set and they closed the week with an outstanding show at the <u>Baccara Swingt</u> festival in Sint-Truiden (May 23rd). One week later the band headlined the <u>Working Class Music</u> Party (May 30th) in Landen. From there on they went to Genk (<u>Hotel bij Ford</u>, June 6th) to finally end these mad weeks on a private birthday-party of a good friend in Diepenbeek (June 13th). Time for some holidays!

During July and August Bacon Fat played some more shows (including the very first gig in Ghent, semi-acoustic) but the highlight of the year was the gig at the Deux Ours Nandrin Festival on August 30th. It was right in the middle of the recording sessions of the 'Band of Brothers'-album and showed a band that was in full progression. That show was shot on camera and you can see some of the songs on the Bacon Fat YouTube page.

The rest of the year was spent on the recording, mixing and mastering of the album as well as the shoot of the video clip. In between the band did some shows but in very limited number. Bacon Fat made a brief appearance on the birthday party of **W. and Neelzz**. They played 'Heartbreaker', **Big Sugar**'s 'Little bit a all right' and **ZZ Top**'s 'Beer drinkers and hell raisers'.

On November 6th the boys found themselves at POG's Irish Pub in Mönchengladbach once again where they did a try-out of the complete new album. And finally they played a 'semi'-acoustic show as opener for (you won't believe it) The Romeo's at the opening of a furniture store.

Obviously the band played a wide variety of stages during 2015, but that may be one of the keys to the success of the band.
